Class Definitions

1. Stock Cars/Trucks: Three or less minor modifications (no motor mods). Vehicle appears stock as produced.
2. Street Rods: Coupes or Sedans built before 1948. Modifications permitted.
3. Modified Cars/Trucks: More than three modifications.
4. Street Machines: More than three modifications. Performance orientated vehicle.
5. Rat Rod: Vehicle partially finished or built-in vintage style.
6. Race Cars/Special Interest: Race Cars (with cage), Kit Cars, or anything that doesn't fit regular classes.

Competition Rules

1. Exhibitor's entry number must be clearly displayed on the driver's side windshield to be judged.
2. Judges must have access to all areas of the show vehicle including trunk, interior, and engine compartment. Judges WILL NOT open these areas for evaluation.
3. It is recommended you are available at judging to address any questions presented to you by the judges.
4. All vehicles must remain in the show area for the duration of the show (through 2:30pm).
5. WINNERS MUST BE PRESENT FOR AWARDS. Awards ceremony will be at 2pm.
