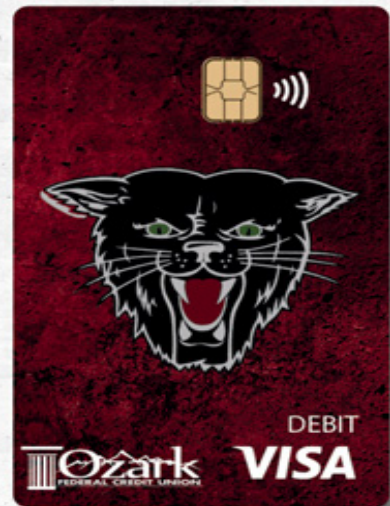

### PARK INFORMATION:

The Dexter Parks and Recreation Department maintains various recreation facilities in the city including an aquatic facility. We have 8-lighted baseball/softball fields, 4 soccer fields, an outdoor tennis court, 5-outdoor pickleball courts, 3-outdoor basketball courts (West Park & Boon Park), Disc Golf (East Park & Sports Complex), tether ball, two gymnasiums, 6 picnic pavilions, 2-paved walking trails (West Park & Boon Park), city fish lake with a handicap fishing dock and handicap kayak dock, and many other park amenities.

## WOMENS VOLLEYBALL

For adults only; all players must be at least 18 years of age. Registration is by team. All teams must roster a minimum of 7 players with a maximum of 12 players. Deadlines in September. Games will run October-January. Most games will be played on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings. Leagues must have four or more teams register.



## BOYS/GIRLS TRACK

Track is an individual registration offered to boys and girls ages 5-14. Age divisions are determined by the athletes age on December 31st of the current year. Meets will run April-May and are held on Saturdays, some Sundays and an occasional weekday meet may be necessary. Meet locations are subject to change but are typically held in Dexter, Poplar Bluff, Jackson, and Cape Girardeau. Registration opens in January and deadlines in March. Individuals may register in office or online at dexterpark-rec.com. Uniform shirts will be provided by the Park Department.



Track is a very parent involved sport including transportation to and from meets and practices as well as volunteering to help at the home track meet.

## CO-ED FALL SOCCER

Fall Soccer is offered to boys and girls Kindergarten-6th grade. The league will be divided into grade appropriate divisions. Players must be at least 5 years old to participate. Games will be scheduled on weekdays and weekends depending on the number of teams. Practices will be at the coach's discretion. Uniform shirts will be provided by the Park Department. Shin guards are required to participate. The league will run September-October. Registration opens in June and deadlines in August. Register in office or online at dexterpark-rec.com.



## GIRLS VOLLEYBALL

Youth Volleyball is offered to girls in grades 4th-6th. Games will be played on weekends and weeknights depending on the number of participants registered. Practices will be at the coach's discretion. Uniform shirts will be provided by the Park Department. Knee pads are required to participate. The league will run September-October. Registration opens June and deadlines in August. Register in office or online at dexterpark-rec.com.

## BOYS TACKLE FOOTBALL

Tackle Football is offered to boys entering 3rd & 4th grade and 5th & 6th grade of the current school year. Birth certificate and school grades report from the previous quarter will be required to play. This is a competitive, travel league. Parents are responsible for transportation to and from practices and games. Practices will normally be held throughout the weekdays. Uniform jerseys, helmets, shoulder pads and mouth pieces will be provided by the Park Department and are required to participate. Football practice pants are also required but are not provided. The league will run August-October. Registration opens in May and deadlines in July. Individuals may register in office or online at [dexterpark-rec.com](http://dexterpark-rec.com).



## CO-ED FLAG FOOTBALL

Flag football is offered to boys and girls Kindergarten-5th grade through the NFL FLAG program. The leagues will be divided into grade appropriate divisions. Players must be at least 5 years old to participate. Games will be scheduled on weekdays and weekends depending on the number of teams. Practices will be at the coach's discretion. Uniform shirts and flag belts will be provided by the Park Department. The league will run March-May. Registration opens in January and deadlines in March. Register in office or online at [dexterpark-rec.com](http://dexterpark-rec.com)



## BOYS/GIRLS BASKETBALL

Basketball is offered to boys and girls ages 7-8-9 and 10-11-12. Games will be played on weekends and weeknights depending on the number of participants registered. Practices will be at the coach's discretion. Uniform shirts will be provided by the Park Department. The league will run November-December. Registration opens in August and deadlines in September. Register in office or online at [dexterpark-rec.com](http://dexterpark-rec.com).



## BOYS BASEBALL/GIRLS SOFTBALL

Co-Ed Baseball is offered to boys and girls ages 5-6. Age divisions are determined by: Boys age on April 30, 2026, Girl's age on December 31, 2025.

Baseball is offered to boys ages 7-12. Age divisions are determined by the participant's age on April 30, 2026.

Softball is offered to girls ages 7-12. Age divisions are determined by the participant's age on December 31, 2025.

Uniform shirts will be provided by the Park Department. Players will be required to provide their own ball glove and we recommend that players have their own batting helmet. Practice will be at the coach's discretion. The league will run May-June. Registration opens in January and deadlines in March. **PUBLIC SWIM:** Daily 1:00 pm- 5:30 pm

**ADMISSION FEE:** \$9.00 - Daily Pass & \$6.00 after 3:30 pm

**FAMILY SWIM DAYS:** Every Sunday during public swim.  
Admission is \$6.00 per person for families of 3 or more.

**OCCASIONAL POOL CLOSURES DUE TO INACTIVITY:** In some instances the pool may be limited or closed due to inactivity

**A WORD TO PARENTS- OUR LIFEGUARDS ARE TRAINED AND SKILLED. THEIR JOBS ARE TO ASSIST IN MAKING OUR FACILITIES A SAFE PLACE TO BRING THE FAMILY. HOWEVER, THEY ARE NOT BABYSITTERS. PARENTS ARE EXPECTED TO WATCH THEIR CHILDREN AND TO ASSIST IN ENFORCING THE POLICIES FOR THE SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT OF ALL PATRONS. IN ADDITION, ALL CHILDREN AGES 10 AND UNDER MUST BE ACCOMPANIED AND SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT.**

**FLOTATION DEVICES:** Flotation devices are welcome at the aquatic facility under these guidelines: Children under 10 years may only use flotation devices when an adult (16 or older) is in the water, supervising the child. The size of the flotation devices may be restricted by aquatic staff. Water wings or arm floaters are strongly discouraged for use as flotation devices. We recommend only U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices.

**DIAPER POLICY:** Patrons requiring diapers are prohibited from entering the pool without "waterproof swim diapers" or plastic pants with elastic legs and waistband. Disposable swim diapers can be purchased at the facility. Adults are required to change diapers at designated diaper changing stations located in the changing room. Children and patrons who have had diarrhea within the past two weeks are asked not to use the aquatic facility.

**POOL PARTIES:** Reservations are taken at the Park office. Exclusive pool parties will be on Friday, Saturday, Sunday from 6:00-7:30pm. Fees for exclusive pool parties are \$315 for 100 guests or less. A guest is anyone inside the fenced in area.

**POOL PASSES:** Passes may be used as often as desired for the entire season during public swim. Cost for passes are: Individual Season Pass \$90; Family Season Pass \$250- 4 members or less; \$55 to add a member (immediate family members living in the same household). During the months of January thru March, the Early Bird Season Passes are sold for \$75 per person.

**LITTLE LEAGUE DAY:** Friday, June 26, 2026 during public swim. Little league day is for anyone that has participated in DPRs youth programs for the past year. Admission will be \$1.00. This does not include coaches, scorekeepers or out of town teams not registered through DPR.

- Practical skill scenarios for CPR, passive extraction, active drowning, and other essential proficiencies
- Pass written exams on CPR, AED, Administration of First Aid and Lifeguarding Skills with at least 80%
- **100% course attendance is mandatory**

## SWIM LESSONS

### 2026 SWIM LESSON SCHEDULE

Registrations will be accepted after January 1st. Registration can be done online at [dexterpark-rec.com](http://dexterpark-rec.com). All forms must be received by the deadline. Instructors reserve the right to determine your child's level of ability and place them accordingly. Participants must be able to be in a group environment and be able to go with a teacher willingly. If participants are unable to adapt to this environment after the second day of class they will be asked to drop the class. Any participant that hits, bites, or continuously screams, cries, or adamantly refuses to take instruction will be asked to drop the class. Sometimes they are not ready and cannot be pushed for this program. There are no refunds. Classes are limited. Each session will be a minimum of 4 participants. The following levels will be offered during each session.

### SWIM CLASS LEVELS:

**Parent and Child Aquatics (6 months to approximately 3 years)** This class has 2 levels and is not designed to teach children to become good swimmers or to survive in the water on their own. This level gives parents safety information & teaches techniques to help orient your child to the water. It will also provide direction regarding how to supervise water activities in a responsible manner. A parent is required to accompany each child in the water and participate in the class. Parents and children learn together to increase a child's comfort level in the water and build a foundation of basic skills, such as arm and leg movements and breath control. The two levels are fun-filled and help introduce water safety concepts, encouraging a healthy recreational habit that your entire family can enjoy.

#### **Preschool Aquatics (approximately 4 - 5 years old)**

Throughout the three levels, preschool-age children are taught basic aquatic safety and swimming skills, while increasing their comfort level in and around the water. Skills are age-appropriate, helping children achieve success on a regular basis and enjoy social interactions with other children.

**Level 1** - Orients children to the aquatic environment and helps them gain basic aquatic skills.

**Level 2** - Helps children gain greater independence in their skills and develop more comfort in and around water.

**Level 3** - Helps children start to gain basic swimming propulsive skills to be comfortable in and around water.

#### **Learn-to-Swim**

*(children approximately 6 years through teen)*

Designed to help participants achieve maximum success, Learn-to-Swim courses are based on a logical, six-level progression that helps swimmers of varying ages and abilities develop their water safety, survival and swim skills.

**Level 1 - Introduction to Water Skills.** Helps participants feel comfortable in the water.

**Level 2 - Fundamental Aquatic Skills.** Gives participants success with fundamental skills.

**Level 3 - Stroke Development.** Builds on the skills in Level 2 through additional guided practice in deeper water.

**Level 4 - Stroke Improvement.** Develops confidence in the skills learned and improves other aquatic skills.

**Level 5 - Stroke Refinement.** Provides further coordination and refinement of strokes.

**Level 6 - Swimming and Skill Proficiency.** Refines the strokes so participants swim them with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. Level 6 is designed with "menu" options that focus on preparing participants for more advanced courses, including the Water Safety instructor course, or other aquatic activities, such as competitive swimming or diving. Each option also includes applicable water safety.
